

NOTICE Nº 322/2019, REGARDING THE OPENING OF A TENDER TO MAKE A SELECTION FOR THE CONTRACTING OF PHD UNDER THE SCOPE OF DECREE-LAW No. 57/2016, OF 29 AUGUST

At a meeting of the Academic and Scientific Committee on 1st March 2019 it was decided to open tenders for the international selection of 1 PhD position to carry out research activities in the areas of Political Sciences and International Relations. The work contract for will be by an indefinite period of time under the scope of the Portuguese Labour Code, approved by Law n.º 7/2009, 12th February and Degree-Law No. 57/2016, of 29 August, amended by Law 57/2017, of 19th July (RJEC).

The notice and the selection boards were approved on 1st March 2019 by the Rector of Universidade Nova de Lisboa. The present recruitment procedure is documentary, has an international character and is opened under the contract program to support the development of R&D activities, between FCT, I. P., and UNL and in accordance with the Regulation of the Scientific Employment (REC) (Regulation no. 607-A / 2017, of November 22, published in Diário da República, 2nd series, no. 225, of November 22).

2. Description of the position:

The procedure is open for recruitment of a job to carry out research activities in the areas of Political Sciences and International Relations.

Goals of the 2030 Agenda: Goal 16. Promote peaceful and inclusive societies for sustainable development, provide access to justice for all and build effective, accountable and inclusive institutions at all levels.

3. The PhD holder will be contracted under the scope of the RJEC and the Portuguese Labour Code, approved by the Law nº 7/209, of 13th February.

4. The PhD holder will be contracted for an indefinite period of time under an a legal imperative, and under the terms of paragraph b) of no. 1 of article 6 of RJEC, ex vi, no. 2 of article 18 of the RJEC, for the exercise of the functions identified in paragraph 2 of this Notice.

5. Under the terms of article 2 of Regulatory Degree No. 11-A/2017, of 29th December, the contract to be entered into is remunerated according to remuneration level 33 of the TRU (Single Remuneration Table), corresponding to remuneration basis of 2.128,34 euros.

6. The Position of work will be at the premises of NOVA FCSH, Avenida de Berna No. 26 C, 1069-061 Lisbon Portugal, and/or other Positions necessary to carry out the research activities.

7. Under penalty of exclusion, only national, foreign and stateless candidates who hold a doctoral degree in Political Sciences or International Relations or related fields may be opponents.

8. The selection of PhD holder to be contracted will be carried out through assessing the academic and curricular vitae of the candidates for the Position in the tender.

In general terms, this evaluation will concern relevance, quality and state of the art: a) Of the scientific, cultural and artistic production in the last five years considered most important by the candidate and connected with the Position in the tender; b) Of the research activities carried out in the last five years and considered to have had the greatest impact by the candidate, connected with the Position in the tender; c) Of the activities regarding the extension and dissemination of knowledge carried out in the last five years, specifically in the context of promoting culture and scientific practices, considered of greatest importance by the candidates, connected with the Position in the tender.

9. The period of five years which is mentioned in the previous paragraph, may be increased by the selection board, at

the request of the candidate when based on the suspension of scientific activity for socially protected reasons, particularly reasons involving paternity licence, long-term serious illness, and other legally protected situations of being unavailable for work.

10. The classification system for the candidates is expressed on a scale from 0 to 100 points.

11. Due to lack of absolute merit, candidates who do not obtain a final classification equal to or greater than 80 points, will not be allowed to take up the position of the tender.

12. The evaluation and ranking criteria for the candidates are the following:

a) The scientific production considered of greatest importance by the candidates, namely books, book charters, papers published in indexed journals, connected with the positions in the tender, to be evaluated in terms of the intrinsic quality of the respective content (0 – 35 points);

b) Research activities considered of greatest importance by the candidates, connected with the position in the tender, involving coordination and/or participation in research projects assessed by national and international entities; submission of approved or non-approved applications; communications given at scientific meetings; scientific arbitration activities; participation in networks and partnerships; the research project proposal and the respective activity plan (0 – 35 points);

c) Extension and/or dissemination activity considered of greatest importance by the candidates, connected with the position in the tender, including the organization of scientific meetings; the issuing of opinions; studies and reports for public and private entities and civil society stakeholders; spreading of knowledge to extended publics; presentation of research results within the media (0 – 30 points).

13. In accordance with article 13 of RJEC, the selection board is composed as follows:

14. The application process for the position mentioned above should be carried out using the documentation indicated below, under penalty of exclusion:

a) Application form, available at <http://fcsn.unl.pt/faculdade/recursos-humanos/concursos/nao-docentes>, explicitly mentioning this notice;

b) Copy of the PhD certificate in Political Sciences or International Relations or related fields;

c) Curriculum vitae of the candidate, organized as instructions according to the systematic numbering of nº 12 of this Public Notice;

d) Three publications considered most important by the candidate, connected with the position;

e) Proposed research project, including scientific publication plan, dissemination activity and funding of national and international funding (up to a maximum of 10 pages).

15. The application must be submitted in digital format, and the applicant must record in 2 (two) PENs all the documents mentioned in the previous number. The documents should be presented in PDF format. Exceptionally, the publications referred in d) of number 14 of this Notice sub-paragraph d) may be delivered in physical format, namely derived from their size.

16. Applications, suitably completed with the documents mentioned above, should be submitted within a period of 15 business days during working hours to NOVA FCSH counting from the day following the publication of this Public Notice in the Portuguese Official Gazette, *Diário da República*, or sent by mail with a stamped date of dispatch by the last day of the application period, to the following address: Faculdade de Ciências Sociais e Humanas, Avenida de Berna n.º 26 C, 1069-061 Lisbon, Portugal.

17. In the case of the PhD of the selected candidate has been conferred by a foreign higher education institution, the recognition of the referred degree must comply with the provisions of Decree-Law No. 341/2007, from October 12, and under penalty of exclusion, any formalities established therein must be complied with up to the date of signature of the contract.
