The Portuguese Institute of International Relations of the New University of Lisbon (IPRI) offers one (1) Research Assistant grant (BI) within the framework of the exploratory project 'Opposition parties in Europe under pressure. Far from power, close to citizens?' (IF/00926/2015), funded by the Portuguese Foundation for Science and Technology/ Ministry of Science, Technology, and Higher Education (FCT/MCTES).

Job description:

Scientific field: Political Science

Admission requirements: BA degree in Political Science, Comparative Politics or other related fields; research experience in Southern European politics and quantitative research methods, notably collection and treatment of data for research purposes; perfect command of Portuguese and English and good command of Spanish.

Work Plan: The research assistant is expected to:

1. Collaborate to the data collection of the laws approved in Spain and Portugal in the period 2015-2018 and to the merging and management of different datasets containing the same type of data, collected in the other European countries included in the project.
2. Arrange and conduct interviews with Portuguese political and economic elites about the crisis of the Portuguese banks Banco do Espírito Santo and Banif and transcribe them afterwards; and provide a press review on the same topic based on the main Portuguese newspapers/magazines.
3. Collaborate to the organisation of the first meeting of the research team to be held in Lisbon, in June 2018.

Relevant legislation: The rules applied will be those described in the Research Fellow Statute (Portuguese Law 40/2004, August 18) and FCT Regulation for Studentships and Fellowships – 2015 (www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/docs/RegulamentoBolsasFCT2015.pdf).

Work place: The tasks will be mainly performed at the IPRI-NOVA, or other location necessary to implement the working plan, under the supervision of Dr. Elisabetta De Giorgi.

Grant duration: The grant will last 6 months, starting on 1 March 2018. The grant might be renewed for an additional 6 months, if necessary.

Monthly allowance: The monthly stipend will be €745 per month, according to the Portuguese Foundation for Science and Technology (FCT) Research Grants pay scale (<http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>) and paid monthly by bank transfer.

Selection procedure: (A) BA final average grade (20%); (B) Research and data management experience (30%); (C) Knowledge of Portuguese, English and Spanish (20%); (D) Interview (30%).

Selection jury: Elisabetta De Giorgi (Jury president); Catherine Moury; Daniel Cardoso.

Public announcement: The final results will be posted on IPRI-NOVA's webpage (www.ipri.pt) and they will be ranked according to their final evaluation. The selected applicant will be notified via email. The jury reserves the right not to select anybody.
