

PUBLIC NOTICE 270/2025

**Vacancy opening for the position of Full Professor in the disciplinary area of Political Science
School of Social Sciences and Humanities – NOVA University of Lisbon**

In accordance with Article 39 of the University Teaching Career Statute (ECDU), approved by Decree-Law no. 448/79, of 13 November, in its current wording, the Dean of the School of Social Sciences and Humanities of NOVA University of Lisbon, Professor Luís Baptista, acting by delegation of powers in the terms specified in paragraph b) of no. 1 of Order no. 181/2023, published in *Diário da República*, 2nd series, number 3, of 4th January hereby announces the advertisement of an international and document-based application for the position of one Full Professor in the disciplinary area of Political Science, to be held at the School of Social Sciences and Humanities of this University. Applications are accepted for a period of 30 business days counting from the day immediately after the publication of this Public Notice in *Diário da República*.

The opening of a vacancy for this position as well as the appointment of the Selection Committee were authorized by an Order of Professor João Sâágua, Rector of NOVA University Lisbon, on the 17th January 2025.

This is an international application procedure based on merit, and follows the provisions of Articles 37 *et seq.* of the above-mentioned Statute of NOVA University Lisbon's Regulation for University Teaching Career Applications, published in an annex to Order no. 3012/2015, of 20 February, published in *Diário da República*, 2nd series, number 58, of 24 March.

I – Admission requirements:

1. In accordance with Article 41-A of the ECDU, holding a PhD degree for more than five years, counting from the day before the deadline for applications; is a requirement for applying to this competition.
2. The candidates must hold the academic title of Agregado (Habilitation) in Political Science
3. The candidates must master spoken and written Portuguese and English.

II – Submission of applications:

1. All applications must be sent to the following email address: drhrecrutamento@fcs.unl.pt. The email's subject line must contain the reference of this Public Notice.
2. Applications must be formalized, under penalty of exclusion, with the supporting documents listed below. All the required documents should preferably be submitted in PDF format. Short names for files are recommended. Links are not accepted as substitutes for these same documents.
 - a) Document proving the fulfilment of the legal requirements demanded in paragraphs 1 and 2 of point I;
 - b) Sworn statement declaring the mastering of Portuguese at a teaching level;

- d) *Curriculum vitae* of the candidate, indicating finished and published works and performed activities regarding all the functions and responsibilities of Professors mentioned in Articles 4 and 5 of the ECDU. The *curriculum* should preferably be organized in accordance with point III of this Public Notice;
 - e) Digital copies of each work mentioned in the Curriculum vitae, detailing which are the most representative of the candidate's contribution to the development and advancement in the disciplinary area in which this vacancy is open;
 - f) Research and teaching development project that the candidate intends to implement if selected (max. 5000 words).
3. All communications and notifications carried out during this procedure will be made by email. For this purpose, candidates must indicate their email address in the application form and sign the attending authorization.
 4. All applications must include a list of supporting documents.
 5. Supporting documents attesting the fulfilment of the requirements for recruitment into public functions can be replaced by a statement included in the above-mentioned application form.
 6. Applications duly accompanied by the above-mentioned documents must be submitted within 30 business days, counting from the day immediately after the publication of this Public Notice in *Diário da República*.
 7. The supporting documents of the application must be written in Portuguese or in English.

III – Criteria, indicators and ponderation factors for the evaluation and ranking of the candidates:

1 – Scientific Component of the *curriculum vitae* (50%):

- 1.1 – Publication of books, book chapters and scientific articles published in journals of reference with peer-review and other scientific outputs deemed relevant for the disciplinary area of the present advertised position (0-25);
- 1.2 – Participation, namely as Principal Investigator, in research projects with relevant impact within the area of this call (0-8).
- 1.3 – Participation in academic juries, both national and international, and in scientific assessment and advisory panels (0-8);
- 1.4 – Papers presented at national and international scientific conferences and colloquia and other relevant aspects (awards, grants, membership of scientific boards, research centers, editorial boards, advanced, postgraduate and further training) (0-7).

2 – Teaching Component (25%):

- 2.1 – Teaching experience within the area and domain of this call (0-15)
- 2.2 -- (Co-)guidance of theses (2nd and 3rd Cycles) and other non-curricular components of the 2nd Cycles (Internship Reports and Project Work). (0-10)

3 – Research and teaching development project (15%):

3.1 – Contribution for the institution’s mission regarding the development of teaching, including its international dimension (0-5);

3.2 – Contribution for the institution's mission regarding the development of research, including its international dimension (0-5);

3.3 - Contribution for the institution’s mission regarding competitive fund raising (0-5);.

4 – Other relevant activities (10%):

4.1 – Participation in academic management (0-5).

4.2 – Transmission of knowledge to society (0-5).

V – Selection Process:

1 – After the deadline for applications, the Selection Committee will meet to evaluate and rank the candidates.

2 – Based on the assessment of the *curricula*, their suitability to the scientific area covered by this competition, the supporting documents and their evaluation in accordance with the criteria, indicators and weighting factors set out above, the Selection Committee will admit the candidates with a final classification, in terms of absolute merit, of 50 or more and exclude those with a final classification of less than 50.

3 – The candidates who are not admitted will be notified to submit their observations, in the terms of the Code of Administrative Procedure.

4 – Once the admitted candidates have been identified, based on the classifications mentioned above, the Selection Committee will issue a written opinion with the ranking of the admitted candidates.

5 – The ranking of the admitted candidates will be determined by the votes of the members of the Selection Committee, in conformity with the ranking presented in the document mentioned in the preceding paragraph, in accordance with subparagraphs a) to f) of paragraph 11 of Article 16 of NOVA University Lisbon’s Regulation for University Teaching Career Applications.

VI – The admitted and excluded candidates will be notified by email, in accordance with subparagraph c) of paragraph 1 and subparagraph b) of paragraph 2 of Article 112 of the Code of Administrative Procedure.

VII – The file of this competition procedure may be consulted by the candidates upon request. The request must be sent to the Division of Human Resources by an email addressed to the President of the Committee: drhrecrutamento@fcsh.unl.pt.

VIII – If the PhD degree of the winner candidate has been obtained from a foreign university, its recognition must comply with the provisions of Decree-Law no. 66/2018, of 16th August 2016. The candidates must fulfil all formal obligations laid down in that diploma until the date of the signature of the contract, under penalty of exclusion.
