InforEstudante is the support platform for students of the Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities of NOVA University of Lisbon (NOVA FCSH). This platform is part of the NONIO system used in the Academic Management of NOVA FCSH and enables:

- · Applications for academic courses;

- Accessing and retrieving grades;
- · Accessing information on courses and disciplines;
- Downloading documents

TUITION FEES – FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Specific financial assistance is provided to members of the armed forces, former members, and their descendants, pursuant to the <u>decree law no.</u> <u>358/70</u>.

Professional firefighters, voluntary firefighters, and first-line descendants thereof are also entitled to have their tuition fees and enrolment charges reimbursed. Order n.° 2236/2020 provides all the information concerning this matter.



RULES FOR ENROLMENT IN CURRICULAR UNITS - UNDERGRADUATE DEGREES

Students should follow the recommendations of the Departments on the enrolment in curricular units.

Each academic year, full-time students may enrol in curricular units worth up to 60 ECTS (Equivalent to 10 curricular units of 6 ECTS). Exceptionally, from the 3rd semester of attendance, students may enrol in curricular units awarding a total amount of 72 ECTS (equivalent to 12 curricular units of 6 ECTS) to compensate for the failed curricular units. 6

CHANGING INSTITUTION/COURSE - UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE

A student may only apply for one <u>change of</u> <u>institution/course</u> (of the same level) at the end of the first year of the undergraduate course. The <u>deadlines and vacancies</u> available for changing the course within the faculty are established on a yearly basis.

For transfer from NOVA FCSH to another Higher Education Institution, students need to comply with deadlines and documentations required by the destination institution.

ANNUAL ENROLMENT

Every year until the end of the course, the student must register for the academic year on the dates available for his/her study cycle in the <u>Academic</u> <u>calendar</u>.

MASTERS

1ST SEMESTER: 19 Aug to 2 Sept 2024

2ND SEMESTER: 20 to 31 Jan 2025

The non-taught component should be registered, via InforEstudante, on the following dates:

1ST SEMESTER: 16 Sept to 20 Dec 2024*

*Except for Master's Degrees in Teaching (6 January to 7 February 2025). In the case of the Master's Degree in Teaching English in the 1st Cycle of Basic Education, the deadlines are from 2 to 20 December 2024.

2ND SEMESTER: 10 Feb to 30 May 2025*

*Except for Master's in Teaching

The non-taught component should be delivered to the Master's Office, on the following dates:

FOR 3-SEMESTER COURSES: By 31 March 2025

*Except for Master's in Teaching

FOR 4-SEMESTER COURSES: By 30 Sept 2025

*Except for Master's in Teaching: until November 2nd, 2025



WORKING STUDENT STATUS

A working student is a student who, while attending a course at NOVA FCSH, also engages in a paid professional activity or is undertaking professional training – provided that the time devoted to either activity amounts to at least 10 hours weekly.

Pursuant to the provisions of the <u>Working Student</u> <u>Regulations</u> of NOVA FCSH, a working student is entitled to specific conditions, in particular exemption from mandatory course attendance. Each working student shall decide jointly with the lecturer of each curricular unit the learning and assessment strategies that can compensate for the justified absences.

Compared with full-time students, a working student may also take double the time to meet the academic success criteria without losing the right to register for classes.

According to the Assessment Regulation in force, working students shall inform the Course coordinator and the Course lecturers of their special status.

Students can apply for working student status upon enrolment, by filling out the form available on <u>InforEstudante</u> and providing the following information:

- Employer's name or declaration of opening of professional activity;
- Employer's Social Security number, where relevant;

• Type of employment contract or declaration from entity providing the training, where relevant;

- Professional Category;
- Working or training hours, including the starting and end dates of the activity.

Working student status shall be in force for one academic year and is renewable upon every further enrolment. Every student whose employment relation begins no later than one month before the end of the semester can also apply for this status.



STATUTE OF STUDENT WITH SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS

In line with the <u>Regulation of Students with Special</u> <u>Educational Needs issued by NOVA University</u> <u>of Lisbon (Regulation no. 397/2018)</u>, students with special educational needs shall fill out the corresponding form available in InforEstudante after enrolment, providing evidence of their condition. This application will be evaluated; if the response is positive, the applicant will be granted the status of "NEE Student", and NOVA FCSH will implement inclusion strategies suited to each case. NOVA FCSH will thus be able to implement inclusion strategies appropriate to each NEE student.

PART-TIME STUDENTS

In accordance with the part-time regime, each semester, students may enrol in curricular units awarding a maximum amount of 20 ECTS, paying a sum proportional to the number of credits awarded by such curricular units. Applications for this regime should be made between the 2nd and 6th of September 2024.



GRADE IMPROVEMENT

Students can apply for improvement exams in curricular modules if they have been approved in a specific course. This examination can only be done once for each curricular unit, immediately after the conclusion of a curricular unit, or in the following academic year, and upon payment of 15€ per application. Holders of scholarships provided by the Social Welfare Services of the University (Serviços de Ação Social da Universidade Nova de Lisboa – SASNOVA), are exempt from these and other charges, except for applications made outside the deadline or when requesting second copies of certificates.

ASSESSMENT REGULATIONS

For the rules governing the assessment of material learnt in the curricular units, we kindly invite all students to read the <u>Assessment Regulation</u> of NOVA FCSH, setting out students' rights and obligations concerning this matter.



TEST SHEETS

Test sheets cost 0.50€ per group of 10 and can be bought from the treasury (B104a) and the Students Association (B002).

YOUR OPINION MATTERS

Every semester, NOVA FCSH provides questionnaires through which students can express their opinions about the functioning of the curricular units. The latest survey results can be consulted <u>here</u>.

Integrated in the NOVA SIMAQ (NOVA's Internal Quality Monitoring and Evaluation System), these questionnaires are designed to assess the degree of satisfaction and help improve the quality of the teaching-learning process. The data collected helps the teachers, the Commission for the Evaluation of the Cycle of Studies and the Pedagogical Council to identify positive points and aspects to be adjusted. The questionnaires are available through InforEstudante at the end of each semester.

The <u>Student Ombudsperson</u> is the NOVA body, appointed by the Rector, whose competence is to assess students' complaints, while being independent and acting in an impartial and discrete way.



AWARDS AND PRIZES

Every year the Ministry of Science, Technology, and Higher Education <u>awards scholarships to</u> the best students enrolled in a Bachelor, Master, Integrated Master, or Technological specialization course of each (public or private) Higher Education <u>Institution</u>. The total number of scholarships awarded per institution is set out every year. The condition for competing for these awards is to pass all the curricular units set out in the syllabus relative to the relevant enrolment year with an average grade of no lower than Very Good (16), up to a maximum number of scholarships per institution set annually.

NOVA has also established a special award, the <u>NOVA Young Talent Awards</u>, for the best first-year student enrolled in each course of its Bachelor or Integrated Master programs. The award amounts to the yearly tuition fees.

To promote excellence and quality in students' academic performance, NOVA FCSH awards the NOVA FCSH <u>Merit and Excellence Award -</u> Bachelors, to the best graduate of each course.



SCHOLARSHIPS

Through the University's Social Welfare Services (Serviços de Acção Social da Universidade Nova de Lisboa – SASNOVA), the university assists students in need through scholarships and emergency support.

All information is available on the <u>SASNOVA</u> website. Details can also be requested via e-mail to <u>bolsas@unl.pt</u> or in person at the Social Welfare Services office at the Campus of Campolide.

The faculty awards scholarships to students with economic difficulties but of academic merit. All information can be found on our <u>website</u>.

The application deadlines for the DGES scholarships run until September 30th. If enrollment is carried out after September 30th, students have 20 business days following registration to apply for the DGES scholarship.

ACCOMMODATION

The Social Welfare Services of the University provide accommodation for students not living at home during the academic year. Information about applying for this type of accommodation is available on the <u>SASNOVA webpage</u>.

The faculty has also some agreements with private suppliers of student accommodation; further information is available on our <u>website</u>.

In the Student Union Facilities, located on the ground floor of Building D (D008), there are posts advertising houses or rooms for rent. These posts can be useful for students who do not know the city and cannot find accommodation through the SASNOVA. However, the faculty does not monitor or guarantee the quality and reliability of these rental proposals, which are the full responsibility of the provider.





EATING

Students of NOVA FCSH have at their disposal canteens, at both <u>Avenida de Berna</u> and <u>Campolide</u> offering meat, fish and macrobiotic, at a fixed price (2.89€). In the canteen, there also is the snack-bar section serving different dishes every day at lunchtime, and a café open for the whole day - for snacks and refreshments. In the courtyard of NOVA FCSH, you can also find the <u>Com Sabor</u> restaurant.

There are microwaves available throughout NOVA FCSH where you can warm up meals.


NOVA students are also entitled to access all SASNOVA facilities and the canteens of the other public Higher Education institutions in Lisbon: the SAS of the University of LIsbon and Lisbon Polytechnic (Instituto Politécnico de Lisboa).



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SASNOVA provides health services to all students to ensure their well-being. Students can book appointments in <u>Psychiatry</u>, <u>Psychology</u> and <u>Nutrition</u> and there are specific agreements with health institutions for the <u>other branches of</u> <u>medicine</u>.

SASNOVA also organises campaigns for blood donation (in collaboration with the Students Union), vaccination, and screening.



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PSYCHOLOGY, INCLUSION AND EQUALITY SERVICE - PSII+

NOVA FCSH provides a Psychology, Inclusion, and Equality Service - PsII+ (<u>psii@fcsh.unl.pt</u>), aimed at fully developing progressive construction of students' personal and professional identity.

You can contact the PsII+ service throughout the year for support on time management, the development of personal skills, or advice on improving well-being. This service also analyses psychosocial issues, offers academic and vocational guidance, provides support during personal crises, or counseling (as exemplified by the program "I've Reached Higher Education. What Now?" aimed at all 1st-year Bachelor's students) and improves the internal dynamics of advisory and training groups.

These consulting services are free for NOVA FCSH students and ensure the strictest confidentiality.

MENTORING

Registrations are open for the 2024/2025 Peer Mentoring Programme, an initiative that aims to establish a one-on-one relationship between a 2nd or 3rd-year undergraduate student and a newly enrolled student at NOVA FCSH.

This project aims to support students' integration and inclusion in the university context, promote analytical skills, critical thinking, and civic participation, as well as stimulate personal and academic development. Preventing discrimination, fostering peer relationships and support networks across all first-cycle programs, promoting sharing, socializing, and cultural and linguistic exchange are some of the objectives of this program.

OFFICE FOR LIFELONG LEARNING - LUÍS KRUS CENTRE

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
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The Office for Lifelong Learning - Luís Krus Centre, (B105b), named after Prof. Luís Krus, former professor of History at NOVA FCSH, is responsible for the organization of <u>post-graduate courses</u> and <u>free courses</u> of the Faculty, the <u>Summer School</u> and <u>New Year's Courses</u> open to the whole community.

NOVA FCSH LIBRARIES

The <u>NOVA FCSH Libraries</u> are open to all students, faculty, researchers, and staff, as well as to anyone interested. They provide home borrowing and interlibrary book transfer services.

The library team also provides training to users and offers personalized and specialized reference services, both in-person and online.

FCSH ID AND SERVICES THAT CAN BE ACCESSED THROUGH IT

The FCSH ID account is automatically created when a student enrolls at NOVA FCSH for the first time. With their credentials, they can access all institutional services and platforms.

The FCSH ID username (or login) is the student number preceded by an "a" (e.g., a2023998844). Upon creating their account in InforEstudante, the student will also gain access to their institutional email after logging into the system.

To log-in to some applications, indicated below, it is necessary to include the domain "FCSH" after the username (for example, a2021998844@campus. fcsh.unl.pt) while in other applications it is sufficient to insert the student number preceded by an "a" (for example, a2021998844).

The FCSH ID credentials are necessary for accessing the following services:

Institutional e-mail: Gmail account of NOVA FCSH; all the communications with the Faculty bodies and services will be made through this account – the username includes @campus.fcsh.unl.pt.

Intranet: Internal information of NOVA FCSH – only the FCSH ID.

Wireless eduroam: Free internet access in the students' residences and other universities – the username includes @campus.fcsh.unl.pt.

Microsoft 365: Freely download and use Microsoft Office on various devices – the username includes @campus.fcsh.unl.pt.

Libraries: for the enrolment of new readers and access to the personal area of the library catalogue – only the FCSH ID.

Databases: for access to national and international scientific publication databases and download of articles, chapters and books.


Moodle: The e-learning system, used in some courses – only the FCSH ID.

Photocopying/printing: Use the multi-function photocopying devices of NOVA FCSH(upon prior payment at the Treasury) – only the FCSH ID.

INTRANET

What is it?

The NOVA FCSH <u>Intranet</u> is an online platform available through the faculty website, used for disseminating academic and institutional information. You should consult this platform regularly.

The intranet provides access to institutional and practical information, such as academic models, partnerships, the NOVA FCSH card, computer information, or contacts.

How to access?

To authenticate, select the Intranet button, which you can find on the faculty website or in <u>intranet.</u> <u>fcsh.unl.pt</u> and enter the FCSH ID data.

Note: New students can access FCSH Intranet up to 48 hours after enrolment.



NOVA FCSH EMAIL Address

The institutional email address is:

"a" + student number + "@campus.fcsh.unl.pt".

For example, the e-mail corresponding to the student number 2023998844 is a 2023998844@ campus.fcsh.unl.pt.

All communication from teaching staff and faculty bodies to students is made using this institutional email (and not the personal one).

Instructions:

a) access <u>https://mail.google.com</u> (the access to the institutional e-mail is through Gmail);

b) In the User field, enter your NOVA FCSH email address, as indicated above;

c) In the Password field, enter the same password that was assigned for accessing InforEstudante.


NOVA FCSH email configuration on e-mail clients

The NOVA FCSH e-mail address can be used with email clients such as Outlook or Mac Mail or those available on Android or iOS smartphones and tablets. To configure your email, please use the following data:

IMAP server: imap.gmail.com - port 993 / SSL

SMTP server: smtp.gmail.com - door 465 or 587 / SSL - use the same settings used for the incoming server.

OTHER GOOGLE APPS

NOVA FCSH has joined the "Google Workspace for Education" program, through which students have a Google account with the usual applications, including Gmail (NOVA FCSH's institutional email), Drive, Calendar, Google Docs, etc.

The storage space available in Google Drive is limited, so for storage, you should use Microsoft's OneDrive, which is included in the Microsoft service 365.



INTERNET ON CAMPUS

Wireless network

The NOVA FCSH's Wi-Fi antenna array covers most campus locations. Libraries, auditoriums, most of the classrooms, computer rooms, atriums, patio, cafes, and canteens have Wi-Fi cover.

Access is made exclusively through the eduroam network, which is accessed with FCSH ID credentials.

These same FCSH credentials can be used to gain access to the Internet in all Portuguese and European universities.

Our <u>Instructions</u> allow you to configure Eduroam on different operating systems.

The IT Infrastructure and Helpdesk Services is available to provide technical support and clarify any doubts that may arise.

Ethernet

The NOVA FCSH study areas are equipped with Ethernet sockets to which you can connect your laptop computers. To access the internet via Ethernet, you must use a UTP cable.



MICROSOFT 365

All students of NOVA FCSH can download and use Office 365 free of charge on multiple devices, such as a PC, Mac, or tablet.

Office 365 can be downloaded from the <u>Microsoft</u> <u>website</u>.

There is a section of the webpage in which students can fill their NOVA FCSH e-mail addresses.

After entering your institutional e-mail address, click on "Start now".

You will receive a message from Microsoft in a NOVA FCSH email, which provides access to the personal area of Office 365. From there you can freely download, install and use up to five copies of Microsoft Office working on different operating systems, such as Windows, Mac OS or iOS.



MOODLE

The InforEstudante is the most commonly used tool for interaction between faculty and students, enabling the distribution of texts, messages, submission of assignments, etc.

However, faculty members can also use the NOVA FCSH Moodle.

To access <u>Moodle</u>, you should visit the platform's page and enter your FCSH ID credentials. <u>To gain</u> access to specific courses, you should request the respective 'enrollment keys' from the instructors.

PRINTING, PHOTOCOPYING AND SCANNING

To print, copy or scan on the Ricoh multifunctioning devices (MFPs) destined for NOVA FCSH students, you need to buy the corresponding credits at the Treasury Office (1st floor, Tower B). Then, at the photocopier, log in with your FCSH ID credentials (important: the username does not include the @ campus.fcsh.unl.pt domain).

The MFPs are located at the following campus locations:

 2 devices available at the Mário Sottomayor Cardia Library, in Avenida de Berna;

• 1 device available in the lobby next to academic services, on floor 1 of Tower B;

• 1 device in the Computer Room of IT Infrastructure and Helpdesk Services Centre, in building D (D005).

• 1 device at the Vitorino Magalhães Godinho Library, in Campolide

• 1 on the 1st floor of Almada Negreiros College, in Campolide, near the building's entrance.

STUDY AREAS / LABORATORIES

In addition to the famous patio of Av. de Berna – a pleasant area to meet and work on the many sunny days – there are study areas available in the library (first floor, Tower B), on floors 0 and 3 of Tower B and on the first floor of the D Building.In Colégio Almada Negreiros you can find study areas on the 1st and 2nd floors, as well as enjoying the green spaces of the Campolide Campus.

The canteen serves as a Student Space during certain periods of the day. However, students can also use the Student Space located on the ground floor next to NOVA Copy. COMPUTER ROOM

Location: Av. de Berna Building D, Floor 0, room D005

Opening Hours: Weekdays, from 9 AM to 11 PM Saturdays between 9 AM and 6 PM.

This room is equipped with 15 computers, about 12 individual desks for laptops (with Ethernet or Wi-Fi connection) and printing, copying, or scanning facilities (credit must be purchased at the Treasury).

STUDENT GUIDE GLOSSARY

CONTINUOUS ASSESSMENT

Process by which the student is subject to several assessments throughout the semester, as opposed to a single assessment or final examination.

PRACTICAL CLASSES

Classes involving the practical and experimental application of theoretical content. For example, on the Translation program, this might involve learning to use software necessary for the practice of the profession.

THEORETICAL CLASSES

Lessons with a mostly expository format (formal lectures).

CADEIRA Curricular Unit

COMPULSORY SUBJECTS

Curricular Units that the student must complete in order to finish the study cycle.

OPTIONAL SUBJECTS

Curricular Units freely chosen by the student from anything offered by the faculty. There are two types of optional subjects: Conditional options (those offered by a particular course) or free options (subjects from any course offered by the faculty).

STUDY CYCLE

Set of Curricular Units which, when they totalize a certain number of ETCS, confer a specific academic degree. Undergraduate degrees correspond to the 1st study cycle, masters to the 2nd study cycle, while the 3rd study cycle refers to doctorates.

ECTS

European Credit Transfer System, also called "credits", reflect the weight of each curricular unit in the final average of the course.

EQUIVALENCE (CREDITING)

Process by which the student replaces a Curricular Unit by credits acquired previously.

ASSESSMENT SCALE

University assessments are framed on a scale of 0 to 20.

MINOR

Qualification awarded to those students who complete a certain number of optional Curricular Units in a specific area of study. For example, a student of Communication Sciences may minor in Sociology.

SUPPLEMENTARY EXAM PERIOD FOR RE-TAKES AND GRADE IMPROVEMENT

Exam period in which students who have obtained a final mark of less than 10 can re-sit their exams, and those who wish to improve their grade, take exams to alter their final results.

CURRICULAR VOLUNTEERING AND INTERNSHIP

Free-choice done during the study cycle that can replace a curricular unit of 6 ECTS (free option).

FINAL GRADE POINT AVERAGE

Arithmetic average of the final assessments of all the Curricular Units carried out throughout the study cycle. Please note that subjects may have different values depending on their ECTS. The higher the ECTS value, the higher the weight of the curricular unit in the average.

AV. DE BERNA WORKING Hours

The faculty is open Monday to Friday from 8 AM to 11 PM and on Saturday from 8 AM to 6 PM, except in August when the hours are Monday to Friday from 8 AM to 10 PM. Closed on Sundays and holidays.
